INVITATION TO BID

1. Notice is hereby given that Senior Canyon Mutual Water Company (Senior Canyon or Company), Ojai, California, will receive sealed bids for performing the construction of FEMA Funding Facilities Repair Service Area Pipeline F2 – Nightingale Pipeline project (“Project”) according to the Drawings and Specifications prepared by Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, Inc.; the proposed Contract, and the Bid Documents.

Senior Canyon operates and maintains a public water system serving a portion of the east Ojai Valley. The winter 2023 storm events caused considerable damage to the Company’s public water system necessitating repairs. The Company has been awarded funding through FEMA grants to assist in the repair work, including the Project, which is generally described as the construction of approximately 850 feet of 8-inch buried potable water pipeline and appurtenances.

3. A pre-bid conference and pre-bid site visit will be held at 10:00 on April 10, 2025 at the job site, located at Lupine Lane and McAndrew Road.

Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened in public and read aloud shortly after the specified closing time.

5. Bid security made payable to Senior Canyon Mutual Water Company is required to accompany each bid. Bid security shall be in the form of a cashier's or certified check or a Bid Bond as required by the Bid Security Document following the Bid Form.
6. Requirements for Prevailing Wage
 - 6.1. Prevailing Wage Rates. The State Director of the Department of Industrial Relations has established the general prevailing rates of per diem wages and rates for overtime and legal holidays in the locality in which the work is to be performed. Not less than said prevailing wages shall be paid for work on this project.
 - 6.2. Department of Industrial Relations. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
 - 6.3. License Requirements. The Contractor shall possess a valid State of California Class A General Engineering Contractor or Class C-34 Specialty Pipeline Contractor's License at

the time of award. If the Bidder holds such license at the time of bid, Bidder shall state its license number, classification and expiration date on its Bid Form.

7. No bidder may withdraw its Bid for a period of forty-five (45) days after the time fixed for the opening of the bids, within which time an award will be made.
8. Senior Canyon reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding.
9. The Bid Documents, Proposed Contract, Drawings and Specifications, and any Addenda may be downloaded from Senior Canyon's website, <https://seniorcanyonwater.com>. Interested Bidders that have downloaded the documents shall email the Engineer, Jack Stobaugh at JackStobaugh@kennedyjenks.com with the subject line "Nightingale Pipeline Project Bidder" and message containing Bidder's name and contact information to ensure receipt of any notices and addenda.
10. The words "Contract" and "Agreement" are used interchangeably and refer to the complete set of contract documents that form the contractual agreement between the Owner and Contractor.
11. Time Constraints:
 - Requests for information received less than 7 days prior to Bid opening may not be answered.
 - Addenda will be issued no later than 3 days prior to Bid opening.
 - Bids shall remain in effect and subject to acceptance for 45 days after the date of Bid opening. If a contract is awarded, it will be awarded within the period that Bids are subject to acceptance.
 - The successful Bidder shall sign the required number of counterparts of the Agreement and deliver them together with the required bonds to the Owner within 15 days after the date of the Notice of Award.
 - The Owner will sign the Agreement and deliver a fully-signed counterpart to the Contractor within 10 days after receipt of the required signed counterparts of the Agreement and Satisfactory Bonds from the Contractor.
 - The Owner may issue the Notice to Proceed at any time between the time the Agreement is fully signed by all parties and 90 days thereafter.
 - The Contract time shall begin to run on the date stated in the Notice to Proceed and the Contractor shall begin construction at the site within 10 days thereafter but not before submitting required insurance certificates.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Bidding Documents containing the Bidding Requirements are provided to prospective bidders to enable them to prepare a bid. Documents that must be submitted with the Bid are listed at the end of the Instructions to Bidders.
2. Examination of Contract Documents and Site
 - 2.1. It is the responsibility of each Bidder before submitting a Bid to (a) examine the Bidding Documents thoroughly; (b) visit the site to become familiar with local conditions that may affect cost, progress, performance or furnishing of the Work; (c) dig test pits or drill test holes to further evaluate subsurface soil conditions to the extent the Bidder considers necessary; (d) consider federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, performance or furnishing of the Work; (e) study and carefully correlate Bidder's observations with the Contract Documents; and (f) notify the Engineer of all conflicts, errors or discrepancies in the Contract Documents.
 - 2.2. Bidder's Representations. By submitting a bid each bidder represents and warrants:
 - 1) It has visited the site and has reviewed the Bidding Documents and the Information Available to Bidders; it has made any other investigations, explorations or tests and has obtained any other data it considers necessary for preparation of its Bid; and it has read and understands provisions in the General Conditions relevant to differing and unknown conditions.
 - 2) It has read, studied and understands the entire set of Bidding Documents including the Construction Drawings, Specifications and General Conditions and finds them fit and sufficient for the purpose of preparing its Bid and constructing the Work required.
 - 3) Its Bid is based on providing all of the material, labor, equipment and services necessary to complete the Work in full compliance with the Contract Documents without exception.
3. Interpretations and Addenda (Before Contract Award)
 - 3.1. All questions about the meaning or intent of the Contract Documents are to be directed to the Engineer. Interpretations or responses considered necessary by the Engineer in response to such questions will be issued by Addenda posted to Senior Canyon's website and noticed by email to all parties recorded by the Engineer as having received the Bidding Documents. Questions received less than five (5) days prior to the date for opening of bids may not be answered. Only questions answered by formal written Addenda will be binding. Oral and other interpretations or responses will be without legal effect and are not to be relied upon by the Bidders unless they are integrated into the written Contract Documents.
 - 3.2. Addenda may also be issued to modify the Bidding Documents as deemed advisable by the Owner OR Engineer.

4. Bid Security. Each Bid must be accompanied by Bid Security conforming to the requirements of these Bid Documents.
5. Listing of Subcontractors. The Contractor's Bid must include a listing of subcontractors conforming to the requirements and format of these Bid Documents.
6. Bid Form
 - 6.1. The Bid Form is included with the Bidding Documents; additional copies may be reproduced by the Bidder.
 - 6.2. All blanks on the Bid Form must be completed legibly in ink or by typewriter. Bid amounts must be stated in words and in figures.
 - 6.3. Bids by corporations must be executed in the corporate name by the president or a vice president (or other corporate officer accompanied by evidence of authority to sign) and the corporate seal must be affixed by the secretary or an assistant secretary. The corporate address and state of incorporation must be shown below the signature.
 - 6.4. Bids by partnerships must be executed in the partnership name and signed by a partner, whose title must appear under the signature and the official address of the partnership must be shown below the signature.
 - 6.5. All names must be legibly printed in ink or typed below the signature.
 - 6.6. The Bid shall contain an acknowledgement of receipt of all ADDENDA (the numbers of which must be filled in on the Bid Form).
 - 6.7. The address and telephone number for communications regarding the Bid must be shown.
 - 6.8. Bids must include a single lump sum price for the Base Bid.
7. Submission of Bids. Bids shall be submitted at the time and place indicated in the Invitation to Bid and shall be enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope, marked with the Project title. The envelope shall bear the name and address of the Bidder and the Bid shall be accompanied by the Bid security and other required documents. If the Bid is sent through the mail or other delivery system, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate envelope with the notation "BID ENCLOSED" on the face of it.
8. Modification and Withdrawal of Bids
 - 8.1. Bids may be modified or withdrawn by an appropriate document duly executed (in the manner that a Bid must be executed) and delivered to the place where Bids are to be submitted at any time prior to the opening of Bids.
 - 8.2. If, within five days after Bids are opened, any Bidder files a duly signed, written notice with the Owner and promptly thereafter demonstrates in detail to the reasonable satisfaction of Owner that there was a material and substantial mistake in the preparation of its Bid, how the mistake occurred, that the mistake was not due to an error in judgment or to carelessness in inspecting the site or reading the plans or specifications, that Bidder may withdraw its Bid and the Bid Security will be returned. Bidder who withdraws its Bid will be disqualified from further bidding on the Work to be provided under the Contract Documents. (See California Public Contract Code 5103)

9. Opening of Bids. Bids will be opened and (unless obviously non-responsive) read aloud publicly. An abstract of the amounts of the Base Bids will be made available to Bidders after the opening of Bids.
10. Bids to Remain Subject to Acceptance. All Bids will remain subject to acceptance for forty-five (45) days after the day of the Bid opening, but the Owner may, in its sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid Security prior to that date.
11. Award of Contract
 - 11.1. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive any and all irregularities in Bids not involving price, time or changes in the Work. The Owner reserves the right to reject any nonconforming, nonresponsive, incomplete, unbalanced or conditional Bids. The Owner also reserves the right to reject the Bid of any Bidder that in the Owner's judgment would not be financially or otherwise responsible or that does not meet pertinent minimum experience criteria established by the Owner and stated in the Instructions to Bidders.
 - 11.2. In evaluating Bids, the Owner will consider whether or not the Bids comply with the prescribed requirements, and include such Alternates, unit prices and other data, as may be required in the Bid Form and supplements thereto.
 - 11.3. Discrepancies in the multiplication of units of Work and unit prices, if any, will be resolved in favor of the unit prices. Discrepancies between the indicated sum of any column of figures and the correct sum thereof will be resolved in favor of the correct sum. Discrepancies between bid amounts stated in words and in figures will be resolved in favor of the amount stated in words.
 - 11.4. If the Contract is to be awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest qualified, responsible and responsive Bidder that in the Owner's judgment will be in the best interests of the Project.
 - 11.5. If the Contract is to be awarded, Owner will give the Successful Bidder a Notice of Award within the number of days that Bids are subject to acceptance as stated in Section 10.
 - 11.6. The Owner's requirements for performance and payment bonds are set forth in the Contract.
 - 11.7. The Successful Bidder shall engage a surety who through binding agreement will assume liability for all debts and responsibility for the acceptable performance of the Work under this Contract if the Contractor defaults.
 - 11.8. When the Successful Bidder delivers the executed Agreement to the Owner, it must be accompanied by the required bonds in the forms contained in the section of the Project Manual titled Contract Forms.

12. Insurance

- 12.1. The Owner's requirements for insurance are set forth in the Contract.
- 12.2. The Successful Bidder shall purchase insurance from an insurance company or companies who meet the requirements of the Contract will provide the required insurance and will furnish insurance certificates.
- 12.3. The Successful Bidder shall deliver the required insurance certificates to the Owner and Engineer prior to beginning work. In no case will the Notice to Proceed be considered as allowing the Work to begin until the insurance certificates are received by the Owner, even though the Contract Time as stated in the Notice to Proceed will commence to run.

13. Signing of Agreement. When Owner gives a Notice of Award to the Successful Bidder, it will be accompanied by the required number of unsigned counterparts of the Agreement with all other written Contract Documents attached. Within fifteen days thereafter the Contractor shall sign and deliver the required number of counterparts of the Agreement together with the required Bonds to the Owner. Within ten days thereafter the Owner will deliver one fully signed counterpart to the Contractor. Each counterpart is to be accompanied by a complete set of the Drawings with appropriate identification which shall be signed by the parties to the Agreement.

14. Retainage. The percentage of retainage that will be withheld from each Progress Payment is set forth in the Agreement.

15. Pre-bid conference. A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. on the 10th day of April, 2025 at the job site, Mc Andrew Road at Lupine Lane, Ojai CA. Representatives of the Owner and the Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Bidders are required to attend and participate in the conference. The Engineer will transmit to all prospective Bidders of record such Addenda as the Engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference.

16. Pre-Bid Site Visit; Access to Site Optional; Recommended

16.1. A pre-bid site visit will be held at the job site immediately after the pre-bid conference on the 10th day of April, 2025. Representatives of the Owner and the Engineer will be present to show Bidders the general location of the Work. Bidders are required to visit the site at the time prescribed.

16.2. The Contractor may arrange with the Owner for access to the site at the Owner's convenience for the purpose of digging test pits or drilling test holes to evaluate subsurface soil conditions. The Contractor shall fill all holes and leave site in "as found condition."

17. Minimum Experience Requirement. Bidder shall submit Bidder's Qualifications, with its Bid to verify it has the minimum experience qualifications required for bidding. In the Owner's judgment, the minimum experience requirement for Bidders to Bid on this Contract is the successful completion of at least two projects similar in size complexity and construction cost to the project being bid at this time.

1.1 Bid Security, made payable to Senior Canyon Mutual Water Company, shall accompany each Bid. Bid Security shall be in the form of a cashier's check or certified check in the amount of not less than *ten percent (10%)* of the Bidder's maximum price, or in the form of a Bid Bond in said amount (in the form attached). Bid Bond shall be executed by such sureties as are named in the current list of "Certified Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds or Certified Reinsurer Companies Holding Certificates Of Authority As Acceptable Reinsuring Companies" published in Circular 570 (most recent amendment) by the Audit Staff Bureau of Accounts, U.S. Treasury Department (www.fms.treas.gov/c570/index.html) and is admitted to issue bonds in the states in which the Project is located and all Work is performed. All bonds signed by an agent shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the authority to act.

1.2 Bid Security shall remain subject to acceptance for *forty-five (45)* days after the day of the Bid opening, but the Owner may, at its sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid Security prior to that date.

1.3 The Bid Security of the successful Bidder will be retained until such Bidder has within fifteen (15) days of issuance of written notice of contract award;

(a) Executed the contract agreement,

(b) Furnished a performance bond and a payment bond fully executed as described in the Contract Forms section.

(c) Furnished certificates of insurance as described in the General Conditions, and

If the successful Bidder fails to deliver the executed documents described above within fifteen days after Notice of Award, the Owner may annul the Notice of Award and the Bid Security of that Bidder will be forfeited.

1.4 The Bid Security of other Bidders whom the Owner believes to have a reasonable chance of receiving the award may be retained by the Owner until the earlier of the seventh day after the effective date of the Agreement or the *forty-sixth (46th)* day after the Bid opening, whereupon Bid Security furnished by such Bidders will be returned.

1.5 Bid Security with Bids which are not competitive will be returned within seven days after the Bid.

Each Bidder shall set forth below with its bid:

(a) The name and the location of the place of business of each subcontractor who will perform work or labor or render service to the Contractor in or about the construction of the work or improvement, or a subcontractor licensed by the State of California who, under subcontract to the Contractor, specially fabricates and installs a portion of the work or improvement according to detailed drawings contained in the plans and specifications, in an amount in excess of one-half of 1 (0.5%) percent of the Contractor’s total bid or, in the case of bids or offers for the construction of streets or highways, including bridges, in excess of one-half of 1 (0.5) percent of the Contractor’s total bid or ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), whichever is greater.

(b) The portion of the work which will be done by each such Subcontractor. The Contractor shall list only one Subcontractor for each portion of the work.

If the Bidder fails to specify a Subcontractor for any portion of the work as above-stated, or if the Bidder lists more than one Subcontractor for the same portion of the work, he agrees to perform that work himself.
